A STRUCTURED JOURNEY TOWARDS FRENCH FLUENCY

Our French language program follows the CEFR framework (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) and focuses on helping learners build strong communication skills, grammatical accuracy, and cultural awareness.

Rather than memorising isolated words, students gradually develop the ability to understand, speak, read, and write French with confidence.

Each level includes:

- Practical, real-life communication themes
- Structured grammar progression
- Listening, speaking, reading, and writing practice
- Interactive learning activities



A1 – FOUNDATION LEVEL

DURATION: 6–10 WEEKS

This level introduces students to the basic structure of the French language and helps them communicate in simple everyday situations.



REAL-LIFE THEMES

- Greetings and introductions
- Nationalities and languages
- Family and relationships
- Daily routines
- School and workplace
- Hobbies and leisure activities
- Food and drinks
- Shopping and prices
- City places and directions
- Time, days, and appointments



COMMUNICATION SKILLS

Students will be able to:

- Introduce themselves and others
- Ask and answer simple questions
- Describe daily activities
- Talk about likes and dislikes
- Order food or shop in simple situations
- Understand slow and clearly spoken French



GRAMMAR FOCUS

- French alphabet and pronunciation
- Personal pronouns
- Present tense of regular verbs (-er, -ir, -re)
- Important irregular verbs (être, avoir, aller, faire)
- Basic sentence structure
- Question forms (est-ce que, inversion, question words)
- Articles (le, la, les)
- Indefinite articles (un, une, des)
- Negation (ne...pas)
- Plural forms of nouns
- Adjective agreement
- Possessive adjectives (mon, ma, mes, etc.)
- Prepositions of place (à, dans, sur, chez, etc.)
- Numbers, dates, and time



A2 – ELEMENTARY COMMUNICATION

DURATION: 6–10 WEEKS

At this level students expand their vocabulary and begin to communicate more independently in everyday situations.



REAL-LIFE THEMES

- Talking about past experiences
- Travel and transportation
- Health and the body
- Housing and living spaces
- Work and professions
- Holidays and celebrations
- Restaurants and food culture
- Technology and communication
- Weather and seasons
- Making plans and invitations



COMMUNICATION SKILLS

Students will learn to:

- Describe experiences in the past
- Talk about future plans
- Ask for information in different situations
- Write short messages and emails
- Participate in everyday conversations



GRAMMAR FOCUS

- Passé Composé (past tense)
- Reflexive verbs
- Direct and indirect object pronouns
- Imperfect tense (introduction)
- Comparative and superlative adjectives
- Near future (futur proche)
- Conjunctions (et, mais, parce que, donc)
- Imperative (commands)
- Prepositions with places and transport



B1 – INDEPENDENT LANGUAGE USE

DURATION: 12–14 WEEKS

At the B1 level students begin to express opinions, describe experiences in detail, and participate in discussions.

- Cultural differences
- Media and digital life
- Social relationships
- Environment and society
- Travel experiences
- Health and lifestyle
- Personal goals and ambitions
- Festivals and traditions
- Problem solving in daily life

Students will learn to:

- Express opinions and arguments
- Narrate experiences and stories
- Discuss familiar social topics
- Write structured emails and short texts
- Understand everyday media and conversations



GRAMMAR FOCUS

- Imparfait vs Passé Composé
- Future tense (Futur Simple)
- Conditional tense (Conditionnel)
- Relative pronouns (qui, que, dont)
- Object pronouns in complex sentences
- Subordinate clauses (quand, parce que, si)
- Adjective agreement in complex structures
- Indirect questions



B2 – UPPER INTERMEDIATE

DURATION: 14–16 WEEKS

Students reach a level where they can participate in complex discussions and understand academic or professional texts.

- Global issues and society
- Business communication
- Academic discussions
- Cultural perspectives
- Technology and future trends
- Media analysis
- Social debates
- Professional communication
- Workplace interactions



COMMUNICATION SKILLS

Students will learn to:

- Debate and defend opinions
- Present arguments clearly
- Understand complex spoken French
- Write structured essays and reports
- Participate in professional conversations



GRAMMAR FOCUS

- Advanced past tense structures
- Subjunctive mood (Subjonctif)
- Conditional sentences
- Passive voice
- Complex connectors
(cependant, pourtant, tandis que, etc.)
- Advanced pronoun structures
- Reported speech (discours indirect)



C1 – ADVANCED FLUENCY

DURATION: 5 MONTHS

Students develop high-level fluency and academic communication skills in French.

C2 – MASTERY LEVEL

DURATION: 5 MONTHS

At this level learners achieve near-native command of the French language.
