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GERMAN LANGUAGE TRAINING MODULE (A1-C2)





YOUR PATH TO GERMAN FLUENCY

Our German language program is designed according to the CEFR framework (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). It focuses on helping learners develop real communication skills, strong grammar foundations, and cultural awareness.

Instead of memorising isolated words, students gradually build the ability to understand, speak, read, and write German with confidence.

Each level includes:

- Practical, real-life communication themes
- Clear and structured grammar progression
- Listening, speaking, reading, and writing practice
- Interactive activities and scenario-based learning



A1 – FOUNDATION LEVEL

DURATION: 6–10 WEEKS

This level introduces students to the basic structure of the German language and helps them communicate in simple everyday situations.

- Greetings and introductions
- Nationalities and languages
- Family and relationships
- Daily routines
- School and workplace
- Hobbies and free time
- Food and drinks
- Shopping and prices
- The city and asking for directions
- Time, days, and appointments

COMMUNICATION SKILLS

Students will learn to:

- Introduce themselves and others
- Ask and answer simple questions
- Describe daily activities
- Talk about likes and dislikes
- Order food or shop in simple situations
- Understand slow and clearly spoken German



GRAMMAR FOCUS

- German alphabet and pronunciation
- Personal pronouns
- Verb conjugation (regular verbs)
- Important irregular verbs (sein, haben, fahren, essen, etc.)
- Basic sentence structure
- W-questions (wer, was, wann, wo, warum, wie)
- Yes/No questions
- Articles (der, die, das)
- Indefinite articles (ein, eine)
- Negation (nicht, kein)
- Plural forms of nouns
- Modal verbs (können, müssen, wollen)
- Possessive articles (mein, dein, sein, etc.)
- Prepositions of place (in, auf, bei, etc.)
- Accusative Case





A2 – ELEMENTARY COMMUNICATION

DURATION: 8–12 WEEKS

At this level students begin to communicate more independently and expand their vocabulary for everyday conversations.



REAL-LIFE THEMES

- Talking about past experiences
- Travel and transportation
- Health and the human body
- Housing and living spaces
- Work and professions
- Holidays and celebrations
- Restaurants and food culture
- Technology and communication
- Weather and seasons
- Making plans and invitations



COMMUNICATION SKILLS

Students will learn to:

- Describe experiences in the past
- Talk about plans and intentions
- Ask for information in different situations
- Write short messages and emails
- Participate in basic everyday conversations



GRAMMAR FOCUS

- Perfect tense (Perfekt)
- Separable verbs
- Reflexive verbs
- Dative case
- Accusative vs Dative
- Two-way prepositions (in, auf, an, über, etc.)
- Comparative and superlative adjectives
- Modal verbs in past tense
- Conjunctions (und, oder, aber, denn)
- Subordinate clauses with weil, dass and many more
- Imperative (commands)



B1 – INDEPENDENT LANGUAGE USE

DURATION: 12–14 WEEKS

At the B1 level, students move beyond basic conversations and begin to express opinions, describe experiences in detail, and participate in discussions.

- Cultural differences
- Media and digital life
- Social relationships
- Environment and society
- Travel experiences
- Health and lifestyle
- Personal goals and ambitions
- Festivals and traditions
- Everyday problem-solving



COMMUNICATION SKILLS

Students will develop the ability to:

- Express opinions and arguments
- Narrate experiences and stories
- Discuss familiar social topics
- Write structured emails and short texts
- Understand everyday media and conversations



GRAMMAR FOCUS

- Präteritum (past tense in narration)
- Plusquamperfekt
- Relative clauses
- Passive voice, Genitiv & Future I (introduction)
- Konjunktiv II for polite requests
- Subordinate clauses (wenn, obwohl, damit)
- Adjective endings
- Prepositions with cases
- Word order in subordinate clauses
- Indirect questions



B2 – UPPER INTERMEDIATE

DURATION: 14–16 WEEKS

At this stage learners become more confident and can participate in complex discussions, understand detailed texts, and communicate effectively in academic or professional situations.

- Global issues and society
- Business communication
- Academic discussions
- Cultural perspectives
- Technology and future trends
- Media analysis
- Social debates
- Workplace communication



COMMUNICATION SKILLS

Students will develop the ability to:

- Debate and defend their opinions
- Present arguments clearly
- Understand complex spoken German
- Write structured essays and reports
- Participate in professional conversations



GRAMMAR FOCUS

- Advanced passive structures, Future II, Genitiv
- Konjunktiv II for hypothetical situations
- Complex subordinate clauses
- Nominalization (verb to noun structures)
- Advanced connectors
(während, außerdem, etc.)
- Partizip constructions
- Extended adjective endings
- Reported speech (indirect speech)



C1 – ADVANCED FLUENCY

DURATION: 5 MONTHS

At the C1 level, learners develop high-level fluency and academic communication skills.



THEMES

- Academic and research topics
- Politics and society
- Media and discourse analysis
- Cultural studies
- Literature discussions
- Professional presentations



GRAMMAR & LANGUAGE FOCUS

- Advanced use of Konjunktiv I and II
- Complex sentence structures
- Stylistic language variations
- Academic writing techniques
- Formal discourse markers



C2 – MASTERY LEVEL

Duration: 5 Months

C2 represents near-native mastery of the German language, enabling learners to understand complex texts and communicate with precision in academic and professional contexts.



THEMES

- Philosophy and critical thinking
- Linguistic nuance and stylistic analysis
- Advanced literature and media studies
- Academic argumentation
- Professional and international communication



LANGUAGE MASTERY

- Idiomatic expressions
- Stylistic precision
- Advanced rhetorical structures
- Native-level listening and reading comprehension
